A total of 72 schools across 23 states have been selected for recognition this year, marking one of the largest classes in the program's history.

Since 2008, the NASET Schools of Excellence Award has been the highest honor a private special education school can achieve through our professional association. The Exceptional Charter Schools designation recognizes charter schools that have demonstrated outstanding dedication to serving students with disabilities. Both awards are bestowed on schools that meet rigorous professional criteria and have demonstrated truly exceptional commitment and achievement in the field of special education.

"Every school on this list represents a team of educators who wake up every day committed to meeting the individual needs of students with disabilities," said the NASET awards committee. "These schools don't just meet the standard, they set it. We are honored to recognize their work and share their stories with our community of over 100,000 special education professionals and families nationwide."

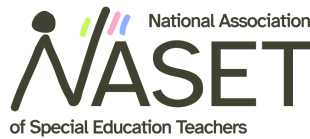

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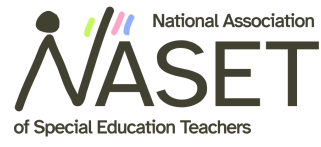
